It is with great enthusiasm that we present to you this year's Alumni Secretary's Report. Our community has witnessed remarkable growth and engagement, reflecting our collective dedication to fostering enduring connections among our members. We are excited to share with you the strides we have made together in strengthening our alma mater's legacy.

Alumni Secretary's Report:

Membership: We are immensely proud to announce that our family has expanded to an impressive total of 1,386 members. This milestone is a testament to the tireless efforts of Mrs. Banerjee, whose dedication has been instrumental in achieving this growth.

Financials: Our financial health remains robust, with diverse revenue streams including membership fees, bank interest, donations, and sales of mementos. This fiscal year saw us operating with an income of Rs. 6,48,381 and expenses amounting to Rs 6,31,041. Consequently, we are pleased to report a surplus of Rs. 17,339. As of March 31st, our deposits stand at a solid Rs. 17,16,884.

Events: While no major events were organized this year due to post-COVID adjustments within the schools' schedules, our alumni actively participated in Independence Day celebrations through a march past and vintage vehicle rally, which was met with enthusiastic participation from our members.

Furthermore, on October 8th, we successfully hosted a marathon that saw participation from 145 students and 11 individuals in the open category.

We also had the pleasure of welcoming various batches back on campus for their reunions—specifically those from the years 1984-86, 1971-72, 1998, 1993, 1991, 1985, 1980, 1973, 1999, 2013, and 1996—making for memorable gatherings.

In addition, it was agreed upon that mementos would be purchased for resale—a venture that gained traction thanks largely to Mr. Yogesh's contributions towards sourcing these items.

Donations and Sponsors: The batch of 1992 continues to sponsor Rs. 24,000 towards the medicine for Mr. Pushparaj's son. A big thank you to them.

The batch of 1971-72 generously donated Rs. 5,00,000 to the association, requesting that Rs.2,00,000 be used towards education aid, Rs. 2,00,000 towards teachers' welfare, and Rs. 1,00,000 towards any event conducted by the association. We are happy to report that we have used Rs. 1,14,519 towards education and Rs. 85,000 towards the marathon. Our heartfelt thanks to the batch of 1971-72.

We also thank the batch of 1993 for their kind-hearted donation of Rs. 50,000, which can be used whenever necessary.

Once again, Ma'am has succeeded in collecting funds to sponsor 10 students, amounting to Rs. 2,15,700 for the year 2023-24. A big thank you to all the individuals, batches, and Ma'am who have helped us achieve this.

Decisions: It was decided that only alumni who are registered in the association will be allowed to visit the school as individuals or batches. Due to various reasons, the coordinator must be informed prior for permission for any visit to the school. Additionally, any individual member wishing to visit the school will do so only during weekends and not on working days, with prior information and permission. It was decided that the executive committee will consist of a Chairman, Advisory Members, President, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, and 5 committee members. Representatives from other cities and regions will be additional members.
